

### (Respect)


It was morning. The teacher said, "Children, listen! "Some children talked. Some children laughed.

The teacher smiled. "Soap keeps us safe."




The children made a game. Who has the big bubble? They clapped and laughed. Clean hands are good. Clean hands are fun.




### 6. The Long Line


### 7. Magic Words

### (Gratitude)


Samir borrowed a pencil. "Thank you," he said. The teacher clapped. "Magic words!"

Family, family—love together!






# Chant 3 Greetings

#### Point and move!


Red, red—touch your head.

Yellow, yellow—wave goodbye! 👏












# **Chant 5 The Weather**

Banana, banana—a yummy treat! 💫







