

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Preface

Rays of Wisdom KG 1 has been specially designed for young learners at Al-Azhar Language Institutes. It introduces children to English in simple, fun, and meaningful ways through short stories, chants, and values. The aim is to make learning English an enjoyable first step while also teaching kindness, respect, and good manners.

The **stories and values** section includes *The Red Ball* (sharing), *The Little Bird* (respect), *Helping Hands* (kindness), *The Cookie* (honesty), *Soap Bubbles* (cleanliness), *The Long Line* (patience), *Magic Words* (gratitude), and *Two Chairs* (friendship). Each story is short and easy to follow, helping children learn English while also understanding simple moral lessons.

The **jazz chants**—*In the Classroom, My Family, Greetings, Colors, The Weather, Farm and Wild Animals, Jobs, and Yummy Food*—use rhythm, rhyme, and repetition to make English lively and fun. Through chanting, children practice speaking, listening, and remembering words in a joyful way.

By combining stories, chants, and values, *Rays of Wisdom KG 1* helps children begin their journey with English while also building good character and strong Islamic manners.

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Stories & Values


Chant 1

Hello, mom!


Hello, dad!

Hello, hello, how are you?


I'm fine, thank you—How about you?

The Weather


Move like the weather!

Jobs


Act it out!

Yummy food



Rub your tummy!


Apple, apple, crunchy and sweet. 🍏
