Some processes release more carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>) into the atmosphere. There are both natural and human sources of carbon dioxide emissions. Natural sources include decomposition and respiration. Human sources come from activities like cement production, deforestation as well as the burning of fossil fuels like coal, oil and natural gas. These processes that release carbon into the atmosphere are known as carbon sources. Forests are typically carbon sinks, places that absorb more carbon than they release. They continually take carbon out of the atmosphere through the process of photosynthesis. 




