Do you ever wonder how long the year is on different planets? Well, the year is the time it takes for a planet to go all the way around the Sun one time. On Earth, the year is about 365 days. But on other planets, it can be much shorter or much longer!

Let's start with Mercury, the closest planet to the Sun. The year on Mercury only takes 88 Earth days. That's really fast! 


